Petition of Baldeo farmer of ~~...~~  
To The King - Shields of the world - May  
his prosperity continue..

Respectfully sheweth - That owing to the  
unsettled state of these times, and in  
consequence of the City gates being kept  
closed your slave had stored the pro-  
duce of his winter crop of grain of the agri-  
cultural year 1264 in the old fort on the  
premises of a station. The Officers of the Re-  
giment stationed there now oppose its  
removal while at the same time your  
slave is pressed for payment of his rent  
for the year referred to by his Land Lord and  
Chumoolka Muzaffer as (rent-free tenant)  
Your slave therefore trusts that an order  
under your royal signature may be sent to  
the Officers of the Regiment stationed in the old  
fort directing them not to oppose the removal  
of the grain to the City so that your slave  
may sell the grain and pay his rent. The Pe-  
tition of the slave Baldeo cultivator of the vil-  
lage Derogah Khadir endowment to the  
shrine of Shureef Azmat Mubarek Chishtee  
dated 5 Zeeat and year of regis 21-28 June 1877
