Before any men are employed to be in the

should be ascertained and after having sent
an order for inquiries to their houses or
having taken their names, their account
and features should be noted down in the
Government office, and after this they
are to be employed in the Magazine -
In this case the Magazine will be in no
danger, but if men be employed in the
Magazine without any inquiries, evil
men having been admitted into it
will commit something bad -

Also an officer and a writer should
be appointed in the Magazine who are
to number all the workmen in the Magazine
& make other inquiries about them
every morning & evening so that
no stranger and villain may enter
the Magazine with the appointed workmen
