for the money advanced by him.*

Bond under the seal engraved in the King's  
special cipher, for money borrowed. Dated  
29<sup>th</sup> July 1857.

To the effect, - That the sum of four thou-  
sand one hundred and ninety eight Rupees  
and nine and a half annas has been paid  
into the royal treasury by Bindratan Treasurer  
as a temporary loan at an interest of one  
per cent. (per mensem) for the payment of six  
months' salary to the servants of the Artillery  
branch; and it has been definitely agreed that  
this debt will be repaid from the loan pro-  
mised by the City merchants. When therefore  
Rae Noorkund Sah, in a few days, shall, ac-  
cording to the royal orders, have received from  
the City merchants the money on loan pro-  
mised by them, the whole and entire sum of  
Four thousand, one hundred and ninety eight  
Rupees, and nine and a half annas will be (re-)  
paid to the said Treasurer together with the  
interest; and no balance to the extent of the  
smallest fraction will be left unpaid; - and there-  
fore the liquidation of this loan, no further

of the money that will be realized (on ac-  
count of the state loan) will be paid by  
our Majesty to any other person or be  
appropriated even to the royal require-  
ments. This document is therefore exe-  
cuted as a bond.
