A petition from Bahadurdeen (Puzakhoth) to the King - in 30 lines - 9 July 1857 -

No. 31 - Surprised, Khan Sufendar & Medicines Khan Golundang of the enemy together with horses having presented themselves before Your Majesty stated that the Battery of the enemy in Subzimmalee has been captured and that two of their guns have fallen into the hands of the glories of their victorious force (rebellious force) - May this happy event be welcome to all the well-wishers of your Majesty - The two men who have come from Sidpore in the service of our enemies but now they have determined to leave your Majesty -
