Sir,

Hearing that Feroy Shah had taken up a position beyond Maltown in the Sullutpore District and having been requested to co-operate with the Troops at the last named place, I beg leave to report that with the sanction of the Major General commanding the Division, I have detached 200 men 1st Madras Native Infantry to Maltown where they will be strengthened by Police.

This will enable the company now at Maltown to join a detachment ordered from Marowra to co-operate also.

The arrangement for the attack has been left with Lieutenant Colonel Dunlop the Senior Officer.
