

**Order by General Muhammad Bakht Khan attested  
with his official seal, dated 23rd August 1857**

To—The Officers of the Regiment of Sikhs.

HIS MAJESTY THE KING just now summoned our Highness to his presence and said he had every confidence that the Sikh Regiment will perform great achievements of valor, and with condescension spoke of you in terms of the greatest praise, you are therefore written to the intent that immediately on reading this order, 5 Companies will get under arms, and go to the Shamgir Battery<sup>14</sup>. You will on no account allow any delay to occur in this matter.

Your Highness, we have learned the purport of your orders, we have to submit, however, that our Regiment went into the Teli-wara Battery at 4 o'clock P.M.
