Petition of Mirza Moghal, dated 2nd July 1857

To—The King ! Shelter of the World !

RESPECTFULLY SHEWETH—That a petition has this day been received from the inhabitants of the City, to the effect that they have been directed by the Chief Police Officer to wait armed and in a body, on the Officers of the Troops arrived from Bareilly. It does not appear what the object of this order is. Your petitioner therefore suggests that such orders as may be necessary in this case may be issued, so that they may be complied with.
