Proclamation

By Brigadier General Lawrence,
 Officiating Agent to the Government General
 dated Head Quarters: Ajmer 1st
 March 1858.

Whereas the troops of the Maha Rajah
 of Holah did on the 15th October last,
 at Holah attack the Residency, and
 there and there most barbarously and without
 any provocation murdered the representa-
 tive of that Court of the mighty
 British Government, Major Birkon
 the Political Agent of Karaulie, with
 two of his sons, Mr. Sub Assistant Surgeon
 Saldar, and Mr. Daniel Kontern, a
 Native Doctor, and by these bloody
 deeds have brought down upon themselves
 the just wrath of the British
 Government.

Notice is hereby given to all
 Princes Chiefs and inhabitants of Raj-
 pootana and the neighbouring States
 that, these said troops and all who shall
 or have conspired with them are pro-
 claimed rebels and enemies of the British
 Government.

Moreover, whereas a British
Army is about to proceed to Attack these
rebels and visit on them the punishment
they deserve, every State and person
in Rajpootana or elsewhere is warned
against affording passage or Asylum
to any person or persons actually
or suspected to be rebels of Kotah
or enemies of the British Govern-
ment, on pain of being dealt summarily
with. All rebels seized are to be kept
in safe Custody, pending orders, Any
offering assistance are to be killed then
and there.
