

**Order under the seal engraved in the King's special
cypher,—dated 29th July 1857**

To—Brindaban *alias* Bindi Mall, Treasurer to the Artillery.

To the effect that a bond, under our special Seal, for
4,198 Rupees and 9½ Annas for the distribution of six months'
pay to the Artillery, as being bestowed on you our slave, it

is incumbent on you to arrange that this money be **forth-**
coming. Be assured that the funds on loan promised by the
City Merchants, will now be very soon realized by Rai
Mukand Lal, when the amount of this bond will be repaid
with every fraction of interest. Entertain every confidence
that most stringent orders will be issued for the speedy
repayments to you of this loan, and that it will be very soon
repaid. Consider this order imperative, and act as you are
being written to.
