¶ The King - Shield of the World. Object of the
adoration of the people and of mankind. Long his
prosperity continue!

Respectfully sheweth! That, situated near the
Court of Justice, there is a Kotha (flat-roofed
house) in the possession of Akiza Kocher &
Soolbann, in the front of which musket bullets
are being moulded; and that the Magazine &
store, which are in your Slave's charge, and are
kept in the halo of public audience, are not in
sufficient safety. - For instance, the work and
other things are lying outside; and the money of
the Army carry away what they please. Your
Slave, therefore, trusts that the Kotha, aforesaid,
may be taken from the Akiza above respectfully
alluded to; and made over to him; so that the work
and other things - all necessary articles - may be
deposited and kept there in safety. - (Prayer for
the endurance of the King's reign and prestige.)
