I am directed to forward for the orders
of Government a letter from the Commission-
er of the Delhi Division No. 40 dated 12th Feb^r
with enclosure containing an application
for payment of Rupees 690 to one Saadat
Khan whose pension was commuted for the
above sum in September 1869, and the Com-
= mutation sanctioned by Financial
Commissioner on the 14th March 1870. Saadat
Khan is reported to have gone to Mecca
before receiving the amount, and appears
entitled now to the purchase money, but
under Rule 8 of the Rules published with
Notification 48 dated 9th January 1870,
the sanction of Government is necessary
to the payment, more than 2 years
having elapsed since it was due.
