In reply to your letter dated the 15th instant
N^o 2483 regarding copy of a Petition from Mirza
Elahi Buz of Delhi, I am directed to state that
it was the intention of The Governor General in
Council to place the Mirza precisely on the same
footing as before the Mutiny. The pensions of
himself and family amounting to Rupees 22,824
— per annum are therefore to be hereditary, on
subject of course like other pensions to the loyalty
of the recipient
