To The King 'Shield of the world' May
his prosperity continue!

Your Majesty! Paying 1200 Rupees into the
Treasury agreeably to your Majesty's order
obtained a document under your Majesty's
signature, assuring us that we should for the fu-
ture have full immunity from all extortion
and exactions at the hands of the function-
aries of the State; the Princes Roy. & of illustri-
ous descent, the soldiers of the Army and all
others. Notwithstanding this, how late, some
Troopers beat upon plunder, this some day
to your Majesty's house in the name of the King
and wish to take our lives or to carry us
away as prisoners. Left without help
your Majesty have been sitting cross-eyed for
the last three or four days; whereas we servants
and retainers know not what to do being exposed
to daily violence and hardships. We have been
reduced homeless as it were, and the privacy
of our families has been completely ruined, so we
are obliged to depart and depart to our homes.

of Mitha from the chief Police Station of the

so that they and their servants may not be

of the City. And we pray moreover that
a written order may be sent to the Chief Po-
