Allow me to draw your attention to the
pension of my relatives numbering 76 individuals
including women and children which having been
awarded to them from 26th of August 1857 up to 31st
of May 1860. But owing to your favor and the liber-
-ality of the Government my services have been ~~terminated~~
from the date of the outbreak. As loyal subjects
and political prisoners of the state they are entitled
to it from the very date from which I have been
favored with the same. The parties in question
having been obliged to incur debt and thereby
support themselves in the interval of three years
after the outbreak up to the date they received the
money owing to their properties being looted by the
rebels. The sum allowed to them in the shape
of pension could hardly meet the demand of their
creditors. Therefore by the favor of your giving
