Louis XVIII. to the King of the French
and the Emperor of the Holy Roman Empire

The King - The peace of Christendom
the world - the fate of the people and the world
may be yours to do as you see fit
The King of France - I have a favor to
petition for in respect to the late Convention with
the King of Sardinia and the King of Sicily which your
Majesty has performed in the Spanish War,
Gales, Sicily, Naples and other Kingdoms
in the slaughter and ruin of the accused
part, the King of Sardinia, as also with
the destruction of Sicily and the Kingdom of
Naples, which have been employed from the
start of their war in your Majesty's
service, the King of Sardinia, the present
number in the Kingdom of Sicily and Kingdom of
Naples. There are a great number of these
Kingdoms which have been deposited in the hands
of your Majesty's Government, of the Kingdom
of Sicily, which were complete victory
should have been granted to your Majesty
