& Majesty's army is now about to leave for Meerut,  
and sixteen men of us slaves are desirous to  
go and fight in its company. - It therefore  
be that a Mirza & Magul may be ordered to direct  
slaves to go also that through your Majesty's  
prestige, never to be overthrown, we may obtain  
victory. It was necessary and has therefore been
