your letter no 1033 of Sept 1899 conveyed Govt sanction to pensions aggregating Rs 22827-6- for Muza Ullah Khan and the more immediate members of his family - No 7 of the list Hooserynee Begum alias Hoosin Hsmanee Begum ^{wife of the Muza} has died. Her pension - declared hereditary vide letter marginally cited - of No 1353-14 devolves on her daughter ^{Moonee} Dogaanee Begum. The Dy Comm of Delhi in accordance with para 450 of the Civil Auditor's manual has applied for renewed sanction to continuance of the pension to her heir, the Civil Pay Master having refused to pay it without such authority. I have accordingly to request that you will obtain the sanction of ~~Superior~~ Govt to continuance of the pension.
