Now I beg to request that I have no one to nourish me and I have left Delhi with my late husband who died in Mecca and I was under his orders & I have not done any harm, and your honor is nourishing our relations at Bangalore & Delhi. If further information your honor can refer to my Uncle Mirza Shah in Delhi. & now I hope your honor would be graciously pleased to grant the Poor Petitioner a Pension for my own nourishment as I am widow & no one to look after me & I hope now your honor will pay a good feeling on me & nourish me at Mecca.

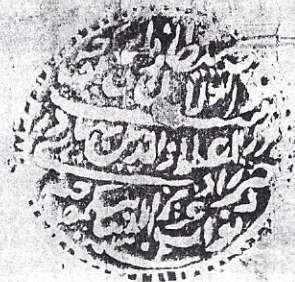
