Secretary to Punjab Government  
Sir, I have the honor, in continuation of my letter No 117 of 16<sup>th</sup> Ultimus forwarding for consideration a petition from George Mahce Ruksh praying that instructions may be given for the disbursement of his pension without sanction to paying the pension at Delhi until final orders are received regarding the residence of the King as he and those dependant on him request themselves to be much distressed for want of money. In my letter No 92 of 7<sup>th</sup> April 1861 I only asked permission of the Govt for the

Mirza's place of residence to be changed  
from Mirashee to Calcutta or some  
place between Delhi and Calcutta, but  
on further consideration I should be very  
glad if the Mirza were allowed to live  
at Delhi at any rate for the present,  
he is the only person to whom I can refer  
for any information regarding the Mirza's  
family; and he is of great use in aiding  
in the management of the numerous matters  
of this family that are in receipt of  
subsistence allowances at Delhi.
