For his services during the mutiny he was rewarded by the continuance of pensions to himself and his family, the payment of which was sanctioned by the Govt of India in Foreign Dep<sup>t</sup> letter No 5281 of 26<sup>th</sup> August 1859. The pensions and Jagirs enjoyed at present by Mingra Dalai Baksh and his family are of the aggregate value of Rs 30,216/14/- as he is put to expenses beyond his present means he has asked for an allowance for his son or for permission to purchase the proprietary rights of Govt in certain confiscated villages in the Ballabgarh Parganah on certain favorable terms.
