I have the honor to acknowledge  
receipt of your letter No 1032 of 14<sup>th</sup> September last  
with its Annexure communicating the orders of  
Government regarding the future residence  
and maintenance of Kinga Uahle Bay  
and the several members of his family and  
directing that the Civil Auditor and your  
Office be furnished with a list of the Com-  
missions for the Muzya and Mithy  
Aggregating Rs. 2,827 6 per Annum and  
a nominal roll of the 76 more distant  
Commissions for whom an allowance of Rs. 100 per  
Annum has been allowed

In reply I beg to forward  
herewith the two Statements required of you  
which have been supplied to the Civil  
Auditor

As regards the future residence  
of Kinga Uahle Bay and the several members  
of his family and dependants I have the honor

to send for the consideration of A. A. the  
Sicut Governor a petition in original from  
the Muzra from which it will be seen that  
he has most deeply regretted being sent to Kurrachee  
Moulmein. I also forward a copy of a letter of  
D. W. Ultimo from the Dy. Commr. of Delli  
in his behalf who wishes him to be allowed  
to remain at Delli -

It has no doubt been very  
useful to us here to know in fact the only person  
left to whom we can refer for any particulars  
regarding the Esting's family. I do not however  
recommend Delli as his place of residence but  
I trust the Government will allow him to reside  
either at Calcutta or at any place between Delli  
and Calcutta to be fixed by the Government.  
He would be quite content with a permission  
to that effect - Two of the Esting's family reside  
by permission at Cawnpore and perhaps the  
Govt. may consider that the circumstances  
of his case do not require his being banished

to Kurrachee or Moulmein -
