Statement of Deposition of Chandul, son of Begum,  
Caste Buzga, age 40 years, resident of Delhi  
Hospital of Buzga Mubarakabad, taken  
before Colonel Geo Hamilton Commandant of  
Delhi on the 7<sup>th</sup> July 1844

The witness deposes that the late  
Azeegooden Alimgoodance during his  
reign granted to his daughter Boudabul  
Begum Khayroonisa Begum, grandmother  
of Buzga Mubarakabad, the following lands  
properties in perpetuity:-  
1 Buzga Asoda - 2 Sampla - 3 Turkee - 4 Math  
5 Kowbas - 6 Khoree - of the Rohituck district  
of Buzga Towla, - 8 Korana - 9 Khora of the same  
district and Mitak's Ladhaura and Peter and  
the garden, then known as Sahibabad Bagh,  
and now as Company Bagh in the City of  
Delhi together with a Serai and other houses  
thereto attached and shops in Chandul's  
and the house known as Hyeeloori Khan  
Ke Haveli. The income from these estates  
amounted to about 5000 Rupees annually.  
These estates remained in possession of  
the above named lady and her descendants  
up to the 4<sup>th</sup> year of Akbarshah's reign

Bahadurshah (the Ex King) then their apparent.  
The conditions of the above were fulfilled up to  
the outbreak in 1857. Subsequently Gode sanc-  
tioned an allowance of 5000 for the life time of the  
Mirza my client. The original Sharnamah  
above alluded to having been filed with my  
client's compensation claim a copy of it is  
herewith filed. Prays that an annual jagir  
grant of Rs 5000, ~~per annum~~ may be made in perpetuity.  
In 1828 the G. G. has ruled that the Jagir <sup>see document marked I</sup>  
Estates held by the King for the time being and the  
family will ~~be~~ <sup>descend</sup> to the heirs of the holder  
as a jagir grant in perpetuity. Besides  
in 1859 the G. G. has ordered that my client was to  
be restored all rights he formerly enjoyed
