Sir

I have the honor to forward in

The services which he really rendered
to our cause in preventing the King of Delhi
going away with the rebel troops is I believe
admitted on all sides. The late Captain
Hodson himself told me that the Mirza
had rendered excellent services.
You are in a better position than
I am to decide whether Mirza Chakir Bakhsh

advised to see cause from the commencement of the rebellion and continued throughout actually to render such active assistance as lay in his power which to the best of my belief was really the case.

It is at all events certain that he did do his best to detain the King from going with the rebels and there is every reason to believe that to his exertions is to be attributed the fortunate result of his capture.

Under these circumstances I beg to recommend him for some adequate recognition not of his services only, but of his proving loyal to us when the rest of the family were to a man against us.

I have to request also that you will consider the filing of these papers as an application for compensation for loss of property caused by the rebellion.

And in conclusion I request sanction to pay up arrears of pension to Major Blake Bullock and the members of his family.
