States that as Gov<sup>t</sup>

any harm to Gov<sup>t</sup>,  
she prays that some  
allowance may be  
made to her for her  
own support - at  
Inceca —

The other petition

is the same, but  
addressed to H. In  
the Queen.

I see from the report of  
Brit. Consul at Jeddah  
that Feroz Shek appeared  
to be in poverty &  
almost dependant on an  
allowance ~~of~~ made to  
him by the High Sheriff  
of Mecca - "the  
only relation he has  
left in Mecca - a  
wife to whom the  
Gov Gen of the Hijaz  
has made an
