Respectfully sheweth! That, with reference
to your Majesty's orders to the address of us
howe soon slaves to go out to fight; and to
raise entrenchments, we entertain no manner
of objection; but this is a day of the week on
which it is unpropitious to proceed towards
the East. We shall accordingly bear at a
moment that will be propitious. However we
will commence with the entrenchments &c at
3 O'clock. We have submitted this for your
Majesty's information. The petition of Ram
Baksh Soobahdar Paltan Alexander, and Fau-
laiyar Khan Soobahdar Bahadour Paltan
Jalaidar Regiment 9th.
