INDIA.

News from Bombay to the 7th ultimo states that a famine is anticipated in the north-west provinces. The people are declared to be grinding mangoe stones for food, and bartering their children to save them from starvation. A seasonable fall of rain may yet, it is hoped, afford relief. The honourable W. A. Morehead succeeds provisionally to the Government of Madras.

The Income Tax Act came into operation on the 1st of the month, and will cease—such is the prospect held out—on the 31st of August, 1865. The act is already in full operation, and the salaries of all officials, subject to its conditions, were proportionately cut for the month of July.
