378 To His Majesty's High Court of the Exchequer. May his  
gracious Majesty be pleased

to respect the petitioners. That the petitioners  
and several of your petitioners before us  
being the servants of your Majesty; and all  
such dignities and distinctions as were con-  
ferred on them by your Majesty's illustrious  
Graces, were as usual in your Majesty's service;  
but the day that the power of your Majesty's  
dominion and power suffered eclipse by the  
change of Government, that same day detestable  
and heinous came to your slaves for aspects and  
parlours. Destitute of affection your slave can  
scarcely to serve the infidels; and accordingly  
continued us year in the rank of a Bishop  
dour. Hearing the name of your Majesty's  
aspect at Portsmouth, we have my Regiment  
it is to be returned & allowed leave from the  
Commanding Officer after a short and dif-  
ficult; and have accompanied myself  
at your Majesty's dear, having left all my  
property in the hands of a Deputy with  
the Regiment in consequence of the departure  
of the English. Besides the loss of the  
property thus abandoned your slave had
