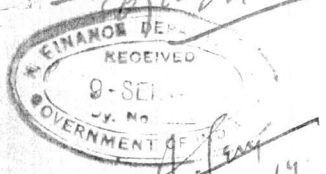

I have the honour to acknowledge the receipt of your letter 1775 dated 3rd August 1914 on the subject of the ---- pensions enjoyed by the poorer members of the Ex-Royal family of Delhi, and in connection with paragraph 3 thereof, to state that the two pensions referred to were not included in the -- number of 148 contained in the second paragraph. As the two pensions were held to have been wrongly transferred they were recently struck off the list by the order of the District ---- Officer.

2. The number of 148 should therefore be raised to 150 by the re-inclusion of these two pensions, and I have the honour to recommend that sanction be given accordingly.


