your letter dt-10/3/37 of 8<sup>th</sup>  
Sept/39 conveyed Govt. sanction to pleurons  
aggregating Rs 22827-6- for Muz. Hakeem  
Berkol and the most immediate members of his  
family and the subsequent communication  
No 443 of 12 June/35 as per margin declared these pleurons to be  
hereditary. The Dy Commr in letter dt 441 of 22<sup>nd</sup>  
Inst reports the death of Kishwar Hamanee  
wife of Muz. Hakeem Berkol  
Beygan dt 5 of the Inst. Her pleuron of Rs  
53 per annum devolves on her heirs in the  
following proportions
