That whereas day after day orders
have been issued to the Officers of the Company to
evacuate the garden; and they have done nothing up
to the present day but make excuses and promises,
definite orders are now issued to the intent that
you and your son will summon the Officers, and
will tell them that if they are the servants of the
State they will not go to the Watershed tomorrow,
but leaving the garden will remove their quarters
to the house of Fiction (a corruption of some English
name) situated under the Palace where there is always
dwelling accommodation and a battery of guns. That
they urge in reply you will submit for our considera-
tion) - Be assured of our favour.
