Don - the illustrious and valiant Mirza Loharooda  
otherwise Mirza Muzul Bahadur Lera!

That we have received a petition from the Officer  
of the two Regiments of Infantry, and of the  
Artillery and Cavalry come from Mudderahad  
submitting that if permission is granted the whole  
of those slaves will establish Batteries on three sides  
and attack the looting; but urging that to construct  
the Batteries the Regiment of Sappers & Miners  
and to protect every part of the rear of the attacking  
force the whole of the Regiments of Cavalry  
present should be attached - so that those slaves  
may make the contemplated attack the day  
after tomorrow - This petition having been laid be-  
fore our divine presence in view to measures being  
adopted to carry out the suggestions it contains -  
you are directed to issue written orders under your  
Seal
