To His ever faithful Viceroy
of Cuttack

Contrary to the proceedings the royal order
and know that your Majesty's High Excellency
of the Grenadier Company of the 15th Regiment
of Bombay - a true Infantry - introduced by the
advice of the State - the honours of the Country in
special place - the honours of the British - Governor
General Bahadour - has come into the royal person
and affirmed that you - ever faithful and sincere
put the whole of the Rajahs (Rajahs) to the sword
have cleaned and purified your Domain (from
the pollution) of their unclean presence not leaving
left even one for the name (of the thing.) He have
been extremely gratified to hear of such conduct
on your part, and you are thus ever honored with
this address to the intent that you will not think
such arrangements throughout your Territory
that none of the creatures of God be in any way
aggrieved or oppressed. Further should the Rajahs
(Rajahs) reach your Territory in any number
but see you will have them slain. In doing this
you will act entirely in accordance with our pleasure

And will be (literally will afford cause for our
complete gratification) and all such desires
as you will entertain, and such requests as you
will make to our presence, will in every point
be accepted. Be assured of our kindness.
