To His ever faithful Viceroy & Governor
 of Cuttack & Puri.

Certainly your wisdom in the royal order
 and command that Girdhainie Singh Bahadur
 of the Grenadier Company of the 15th Regiment
 Bombay Native Infantry - introduced by the
 advice of the State - the honor of the Country in
 special honor - has now put the Viceroy & Governor
 General Bahadur - has come into the royal presence
 and affirmed that you ever faithful one, having
 put the whole of the Rajahs (Rajpoots) to the sword
 have cleansed and purified your Domain (from
 the pollution) of their unclean presence and having
 left even one for the name (of the thing) He have
 been extremely gratified to hear of such conduct
 on your part, and you are therefore honored with
 this address to the intent that you will institute
 such arrangements throughout your Territory
 that none of the creatures of God be in any way
 aggrieved or oppressed. Further should the Rajahs
 (Rajpoots) reach your Territory in any number
 by sea you will have them slain. In doing this
 you will act entirely in accordance with our pleasure

and will (literally will afford cause for our
complete gratification) and all such desires
as you will entertain, and such requests as you
will make to our presence will in every point
be accepted. Be assured of our kindness.

Dated the 16th of July year 1773. Signed in the presence
with the yeoman of our glorious reign.
