

Copy of a letter No 1015 G. dated
Simla, the 14th May 1886, from the
Junior Under Secretary to the Govern-
ment of India Foreign Department
to the Secretary to Government, Punjab

In reply to your letter No 309
dated the 28th April 1886, I am directed
to state that the Government of India
sanction the grant of an allowance
of Rs 31. per mensem each to Mu-
hammad Suttan and Mahmud
Suttan, the two minor sons of the
late Mirza Haji, a member of the ex.
Royal Family of Delhi, until they
attain the age of 18 years, the allowance
to be continuable, in each case, for three
years longer, if proper arrangements
are made for educating or providing
the grantees with the means of
earning an honest livelihood.

from the 13th May 1885, the day following
