is entrusted to you our son, and it easily ma-  
nages, in as much, as each individual re-  
ceives the full amount of his claim. - In the same

you will be able to give to different portions of  
the Army. Cavalry and Infantry such quantities  
as they may severally require, and they will receive  
them at once. - Be assured of our kindness.
