4. \_\_\_\_\_ I have the honor to suggest that the Secretary of Government be moved to send a copy of the Government order, sanctioning the distribution of the pension, to the Accountant General, with a view to the usual permanent payable Orders being prepared with as little delay as possible. \_\_\_\_\_
