June 28, 1857 ; no. 3.

Subject.

The Nawab of Thajjar (Md. Abdur Rahman Khan) to The King (Bahadur Shah II). Says that he has duly instructed the Tahsildar of Basli to take proper steps for the storage and supply of grains. (5th Zilqada, 1273 = 28th June, 1857).
