2. The Pension was granted until Mirza Bakhtawar Shah attained the age of 18 years, and continuable thereafter at the discretion of the Local Government for another four years.

3. Bakhtawar Shah attained the age of 18 years on the 1<sup>st</sup> March 1903, and the Pension then ceased.

Under the conditions of the sanction however the Pension may be continued for another four years

of it is then shewn that the boy  
has not obtained employment  
& is industrious, and if it appears  
that he may better be able to earn  
his livelihood if his education is  
prolonged.

4. I have made enquiries in  
regard to the boy & find that he  
has not yet obtained employment.

He is reported to have been  
diligent at School, and I am of  
opinion that he would certainly be  
in a better position to earn his live-  
lihood if his education were  
prolonged. I accordingly recom-  
mend that his Pension be con-  
tinued for another four years,  
or till he attains the age of 22  
years, the Pension to be continued  
from the date on which it ceased,  
that is from 1<sup>st</sup> March 1903.
