Petition from Zabbai Khan attached
to the Police Station of Bussunt dated
16 June 1857.

To The King adored by the world.
I have this day received certain information
that near 2000 troops, that revolted from the
English and are now coming from Kus-
seen abad: are today encamped at Gurhee
Gurdunoo and will be here tomorrow. There
is no means of arranging for the usual sup-
plies at this place. I hope therefore that some
officer or Trooper will be deputed by your obe-
dience on this duty. There intervene prayers for
the continuance of the King's wealth and power.
A further prayer is that your petitioner had
no previous information of the approach of
these troops or he might have made ar-
rangements in anticipation. The informa-
tion today was quite unexpected. May it
be suggested that such orders should now
be issued as can be carried out. Signed the
Slave Zabbai Khan attached to the Police
Station of Bussunt. Dated 23rd Shu waut
